Graduate Assistant On the Job Injury (OJI)

If a graduate student is injured while performing duties as a Graduate Assistant student employee, said student should be seen by USA Student Health Services. Serious injuries should be sent to the emergency room of the University of the South Alabama Medical Center. If time is of the essence, based on the severity of the injury, the graduate student employee may be taken to the nearest emergency department. If the graduate student sustains an injury that is not serious enough to warrant emergency room treatment, and wishes to be considered for OJI benefits by the University, the graduate student must report to the USA Student Heal

2. All claims for property damage and/or medical expenses not paraduate student's insurance may be filed by the graduate student Adjustment. Approval by the State Board of Adjustment is based accident by University officials and a determination by the State occurred while on the job. A letter explaining the State Board's requirements along with the appropriate claim forms can be obtat USA's Office of Risk Management, CSAB 216.
